Institutional Development Plan (IDP)

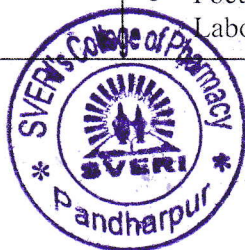
A.Y. 2023-2024
